# **Election Notice for the South/West Region Executive Board Positions**

In accordance with Article 14 of Local 8's Bylaws, this is notification that a mail ballot election will take place for 5(five) South/West Region

Executive Board Positions to fill 3-year terms. Only members in good standing who reside in the South/West Region will receive ballots and are eligible to vote for 5 (five) of the candidates below. The South/West Region includes Clallam, Jefferson, Kitsap, Mason, Grays Harbor, Thurston, Pierce, Pacific, Lewis, Cowlitz, Wahkiakum, Clark and Skamania Counties. The secret mail ballots will be sent from the Local 8 office on Friday, February 5 and will need to be returned to the election post box in time to be picked up by the afternoon mail on Wednesday, February 24. Ballots cannot be hand delivered; they can only be received in the special election post box that is identified in the voting packet. The results of the election will be posted on the Local 8 website at www.opeiu8.org.
