



For Local 8 Members at Washington State Ferries

September 23, 2021

When we were in contract negotiations last summer, Washington State was in the midst of shutdowns due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Ferry travel was down to historic lows. It was a tough environment to bargain in as revenue streams were down and the budget was headed into a downward spiral. During that time, the State wouldn't agree to wage increases, in fact they were stating more furloughs would be needed.

While we are still grappling with a global pandemic, businesses have found a way to reopen and the economy has begun to bounce back. Since the State's budget is better than anticipated, we re-opened negotiations over compensation.

We were able to reach an Agreement that includes (see attached for more details):

- 3.25% base wage increase effective July 1, 2022; and
- Lump sum payments effective July 1, 2022 based on an employee's base salary
