Wage Increase for CNAs!

We are happy to announce that OPEIU Local 8 has reached an agreement with FTJ to increase the hourly wage rates for CNAs!

FTJ has been experiencing a serious problem with recruitment of new employees and retaining employees due to low wage rates. This caused a high need to supplement with agency workers.

The new wage scale for CNAs is still based on years of long-term care experience at the certification level but the rates for years of experience are increased. Depending on your experience level, the increase is between 4% and 30%.

I have attached the new wage matrix for you to see the changes which will become effective with the November 8th pay period.
