

Are you being paid correctly? Check Your Anniversary Date (Step Increase Date)



HRConnect, our Union has been actively addressing many errors in pay that members have experienced. We will continue to hold management accountable for these errors, but it's also important that each of us review our pay on a regular basis, so that these errors can be caught and resolved. It is our contractual right to be paid correctly for the work we do, and KPWA must fix these errors in a timely manner.

If you notice that your seniority date is incorrect, or you do not believe you were paid for your step increase on time (or correctly), please fill out the correct form below.
