## **Bargaining Update**

We continue to make progress at the bargaining table, though we remain apart on wages and workload.

At our last session on Friday March 31, Sea Mar agreed that, outside of a critical need to retain an employee, transfers will be complete within four weeks of accepting a new position. They also agreed that if the employee's new role is a higher wage, they will be paid the higher wage after two weeks, regardless of if they've moved into their new role.

We reached agreement on three paid days for jury duty, on a more flexible dress code, and on more flexible language around bereavement leave (two additional days which employees can choose to use PTO or take it unpaid) for an employee who is required to travel more than 500 miles.

Our highest priorities – wage increases, addressing workload, and multilingual pay - continue to be negotiated. We must show Sea Mar we are united and continue to apply pressure to get a fair increase that recognizes our commitment to our community.

We return to the bargaining table April 14.
