Our bargaining team continues to advocate for us at the bargaining table by raising concerns about safety, high turnover, and toxic work environments.

Our voices are what moves management at the bargaining table. Our petition is the best way to make our voices heard.

We will no longer accept no movement in the cost-of-living wage and our annual wages, This is unacceptable! It is time to stand up for what we deserve, we are keeping these doors open and doing the important work every day with our clients and patients.
