Introducing Union Representative, Phoebe Feldsher:



Initiation Fees Explained:

Any employee hired before April 1, 2023 **does not** pay an initiation fee to OPEIU LOCAL 8! We waived this deduction for employees that were employed at the time the initial contract went into effect.

For employees hired after April 1, 2023, the initiation fee is based on a sliding scale (\$20-\$150) taking into consideration FTE and income. However, if you attend a qualifying union meeting during your first year of employment, we'll reimburse you 50% of the initiation fee. See list of qualifying meetings here!
