

Emergency Teach-in TONIGHT!

Seattle King County Coalition on Homelessness is hosting an emergency teach-in at 6:30 pm tonight in response to an upcoming Seattle City Council vote on a bill to criminalize drug possession and public use of drugs.

The City of Seattle's budget is already tight, and this bill will take money away from human services and put it in the criminal justice system. We've fought hard to get higher wages, we can't allow this bill to pass.
