## Strength Through Solidarity: Central Supply & Distribution Workers Win Against Rebid

In late September, Providence informed Central Supply & Distribution that hospital management wanted to change the department to 10-hour shifts. The hospital was asking employees to bid into new shifts with no schedule patterns and no guaranteed regular days on or off. Central Supply & Distribution workers believed the rebid to be an unfair change that would provide them with no predictability in their schedules and leave them unable easily to plan for their lives outside of work.

In response, our union filed a grievance against the rebid and union members in the department quickly organized their coworkers to take action to push back against management, including getting a majority of department workers to sign a petition condemning the plan and supporting their grievance.

Two weeks later, before our coworkers had a chance to deliver their petition, HR and Department Management announced that they would rescind their rebid plans! This incredible victory shows loud and clear: When we organize and fight as a collective, we have the power to win.
