Union Vacancies on the LIHI Monthly Safety Committee

Below is some information regarding the ins and outs of the State required Safety Committee Meetings. **LIHI Safety Committee Meeting meets the last Thursday of each month from 3 - 4 p.m.** This meeting is virtual and is on paid time. If you are interested in representing your Union co-workers in this meeting reach out to your Union Representative Erin Adamson at erin@opeiu8.org or Shelby Mooney at Shelby@opeiu8.org.

Washington Department of Labor and Industries WAC-296-800-130. Every employer with 11 or more employees is required to establish a safety committee to address employee safety and health concerns. These meetings must occur monthly.

The Committee Consists of:

- Employee-elected and employer-selected members.
- The number of employee-elected members must equal or exceed the number of employer-selected members.
 - Note: Employees selected by the employees bargaining representative or union qualify as employee-elected.

- If there is an employee-elected member vacancy, a new member must be elected prior to the next scheduled meeting.
- Has an elected chairperson. (Union members are equals in this committee)

The Safety Committee Must Cover these Topics:

- Review safety and health inspection reports to help correct safety hazards.
- Evaluate the accident investigations (incident reports) submitted since the last meeting to determine if the cause(s) of the unsafe situation was identified and corrected.
- Evaluate your workplace accident and illness prevention program and discuss recommendations for improvement, if needed.
